Dear Residents & Families,

Good morning from The Villas, I wanted to share some good news that we had a successful round of COVID testing this previous Monday the 19<sup>th</sup> and I am happy to report that all residents and staff members that were tested came back with negative results. This is good news however we're not completely out of the woods yet. Per the guidance of Placer County Health and Community Care Licensing we have been directed to keep our memory care section quarantined until we complete a second round of testing which is expected to take place this coming Monday October 26<sup>th</sup>. The turn around time for test results was reasonably quick this last time so I expect that we should be able to resume visitation for our memory care population fairly soon.

We're sensitive to the strain that this puts on our residents and families however we feel it is best to play it safe and follow the guidance of County Health Officials. As soon as we get the "all clear" we will put out a message letting everyone know it is safe to return to visit at The Villas. For now though we can rejoice in that our first round of testing was a success however in the meantime we will maintain all necessary precautions to ensure the safety and security of your loved ones.
