Dear Residents & Families,

Earlier this week on Monday October 26th we had a second round of COVID testing administered for our Memory Care population and our staff. As of this morning we received all of the results back for all residents and staff and I am pleased to report that all of the results came back negative for COVID-19. This is good news and we're happy that this recent saga is behind us. We will still remain on high alert for anything adverse concerning the residents or staff but I have been in contact with both Community Care Licensing and also Placer County Health and we have received approval to resume visitation here at The Villas.

As a reminder, we are still only allowing two visitors at a time and visits do need to be scheduled in advance with our concierge desk. Visitors need to be screened for symptoms and have their temperature taken upon arrival and complete our health screening declaration form. Masks are required to be worn throughout the duration of your visit and social distancing must be observed. If you have any questions regarding this please contact us.

Lastly, I would add that I am glad to have this behind us but we will continue to remain mechanized to shut down again if needed. In this last episode we were lucky that we were able to prevent transmission of the virus and I can say with confidence that we achieved this by maintaining a constant state of readiness. We don't necessarily expect to have future cases but we will remain prepared and ready to act in the event that we do. Your loved one's safety will always come first here at The Villas so we appreciate your understanding in advance if we should have to quarantine again in the future.
