Dear Residents & Families,

Good afternoon from The Villas, we hope you are doing well. With the holidays approaching we here at The Villas really want to do everything we can to ensure that you have a fun but more importantly a safe holiday season. Unfortunately, this time of year does not lend itself to the concept of social distancing but we do want to do what we can and make this year's holidays as special as possible.

As we approach each holiday this year, we will keep you updated as to what will be going on in the community and current precautionary measures we're taking but I wanted to put out some general information for Thanksgiving since it is rapidly approaching. First, I have been approached by many of you on whether or not we will be allowing guests to dine with us. Unfortunately, at this time we will not be able to host guests for dining as per state and county guidelines. That said we expect that some residents may venture out of the community with family which again as you have heard me say on many occasions, we don't necessarily advise leaving the community, however we are not in a position to stop you from doing so.

If you are planning on venturing out and expect to be away for multiple days please notify our care staff in advance so that we can prepare your medications upon your departure. If you are leaving, we will not expect that you self-isolate upon return but we do ask that you be extra cautious and maintain safe distancing at all times. Public Health guidance suggests that for families that are holding gatherings that they keep it to no more than sixteen people at a time and no more than three households. With reported COVID cases increasing every day in Placer County, we and your fellow residents are counting on you to make good decisions and be safe.

As we get closer to Thanksgiving Day, we will announce more information on our menu and dining times. We realize that with COVID the holiday experience will be different this year but we still will aim high to make the best of it. We sincerely hope that you have a safe and wonderful Thanksgiving Holiday and again please be as safe as possible.
